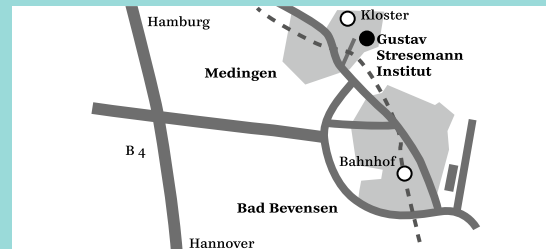
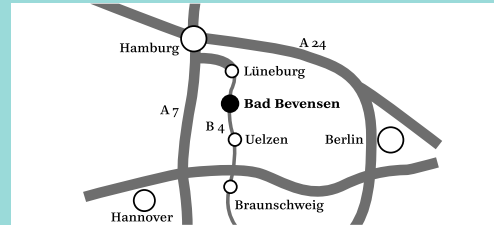

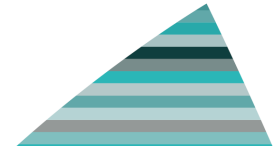

LIVING TOGETHER IN DIVERSITY AND RESOLVING CONFLICTS - WHAT DOES IT MEAN IN ISRAEL AND GERMANY?

This seminar addresses youth leaders, out of school educators, teachers, students, etc.. in both countries. The focus will be on the question, how a peaceful living together in complex societies can be promoted with the help of pedagogical approaches, which are developed in both societies to strengthen democratic competencies and to raise an attitude of respect towards the other. Participants should not only get to know these dialog-orientated concepts theoretically, but by experience and common reflection upon personal insights. More over the opportunity to learn from each other will be given by the presentation of good practice examples of projects dealing with different cultural groups, milieus, beliefs, lifestyles, etc... The first part will be the seminar in Bad Bevensen and Berlin , the **second part** will be from **9th to 16th of March in 2017 in Israel.**

TUESDAY, 02.08.2016

9 - 10.30 am

"Casino of encounters"

- Simulation game and evaluation: Feelings, behaviour and strategies for dealing with cultural overlap-situations

11 am - 12.30 pm

"4 ways to deal with (intercultural) conflicts", introduction and transfer to the German and the Israeli society

- work in bilateral groups and plenary-discussion :
"Similarities and differences in our societies"

2.30 - 4 pm

"Intercultural competency and the ability to deal with diversity - What does this mean?"

- Introduction to goals, conceptions and learning-levels

Followed by: "I can see, what you can't see..." -

Exercises regarding mechanisms of perception and stereotype building

4.30 - 6 pm

- Continuation with transfer to the images of oneself and "the other" in the German-Israeli and Arabic-Jewish relationship

- Followed by: "A single story", talk of Chimamanda Adichie on video. Followed by: "A single story of mine..." (individual reflection), figure out strategies to duplicate single stories and to "discover the paradise" (work in groups)
